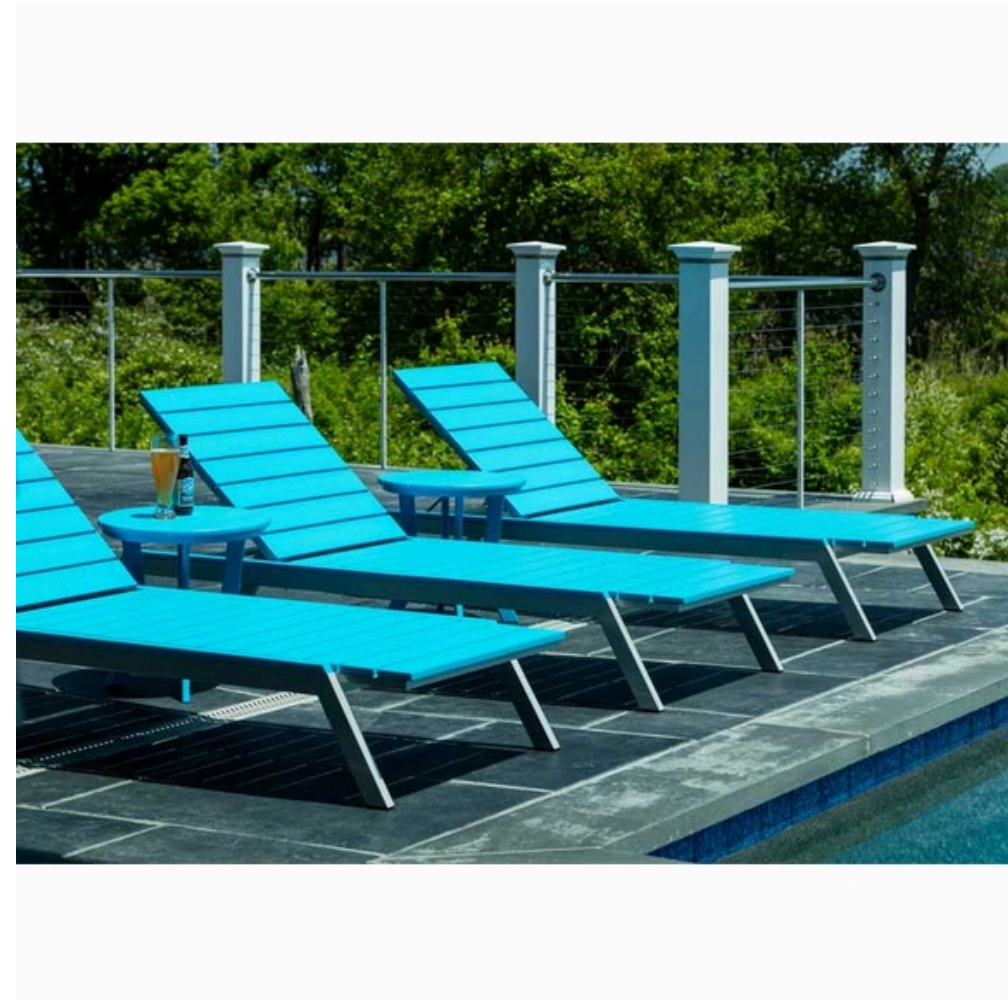

Every chair holds approximately twelve hundred reprocessed gallon jugs. The company is fond of mention how every company piece bought saves several hundred in pounds in refuse from reaching trash heaps plus the sea, but the more profound fact remains that the resin proves just the best choice in the task. HDPE is roughly around the same mass as timber, HDPE refuses to become noticeably scorching compared to natural wood in direct sun (a typical myth with plastic outdoor chairs), and this resin doesn't care about wood-boring insects, salt spray, together with the bleach that causes cheaper materials fragile. The company's literature promises a fifty-year life expectancy for commercial use; the vintage seats in continuous duty, down in the iconic Del in San Diego, are today crossing 35+ years and continue performing well.
