

Snorkel gear quality makes a significant difference to the underwater experience. Kaanapali Ocean Adventures provides quality snorkel equipment as part of every tour, and the crew ensures every guest has a properly fitting setup before entering the water. The mask is the most important piece of snorkel equipment for comfort and vision. A properly fitting mask creates a watertight seal across the face without pressing uncomfortably. When trying the provided mask, place it against your face without using the strap and breathe in gently through your nose. A mask that stays in place without the strap fits well. Masks that let in water are almost always a fit issue rather than a quality issue. The snorkel should feel comfortable in the mouth with the mouthpiece firmly held between the teeth and lips. If you are experiencing jaw fatigue from gripping **Kaanapali Snorkel Tours** the mouthpiece, the snorkel may be slightly too large for your jaw. Inform the **Kaanapali snorkel excursions** crew and they can try a different option.

Fins improve propulsion significantly for most snorkelers. Full-foot fins that fit snugly produce better propulsion than loose fins that slip. Wearing thin socks inside rental fins can solve the loose fit problem and prevent heel blisters on longer snorkel sessions. If you have a mask or snorkel you prefer from previous snorkeling experience, you are welcome to bring it on your Kaanapali Ocean Adventures tour. The crew provides equipment but guests are welcome to use their own. For first-time snorkelers uncertain about any aspect of gear use, the crew's safety briefing covers all essentials. Clearing a flooded mask, breathing through the snorkel, and entering and exiting the water with fins on are all covered before anyone enters the water. Sea Scooters require a brief additional orientation. The crew demonstrates proper hold and operation before guests take them into the water. Call +1 808-633-3138 to book your tour.
