

Michigan doesn't give out simple days to paint a home. One week it's 58 degrees and crisp, the following it's 82 with an electrical storm dashing throughout Washtenaw Area. I have actually watched fresh trim flash-dry in a hot crosswind, seen cedar siding sweat resin in August, and stood with a dampness meter on a clouded October early morning waiting on the dew to burn off. The key to a flawless coating in Ypsilanti is not only product and technique. It's timing, series, and a mindful analysis of the sky.

- Masonry with efflorescence. White salts blooming on brick or block mean moisture movement. No topcoat resolves it till the resource is attended to.
