On one multifamily home, a business proposed glue catches and monthly spray downs for computer mice. Another bid was 40 percent greater and included sealing 35 infiltrations, mounting door moves, and getting rid of the dumpster overflow. The second plan decreased call-backs by 90 percent within two months, and the total year cost was lower.

Red flags that predict headaches
