The core chemistry: peroxide and oxygen radicals

Most professional whitening gels are hydrogen peroxide or carbamide peroxide. Carbamide peroxide breaks down into hydrogen peroxide and urea, so consider it as a slower launching variation. Hydrogen peroxide is the active lightening species throughout products.

When peroxide decomposes, it launches reactive oxygen species that assault the conjugated double bonds in pigmented particles. Diffusion matters. Peroxide is small enough to travel through enamel prisms and reach dentin within minutes. The response rate depends upon temperature level, pH, concentration, and time. Raise the concentration and you get faster whitening with a higher danger of sensitivity. Adjust pH higher, into the 6.5 to 9 range, and peroxide continues longer. Warmer gels react faster. Dentists handle all 4 variables.
