- Clean and straighten the photo-eyes. Clean both sensing unit lenses with a soft towel. The lights on each sensing unit need to be steady, not flickering. Readjust the brackets so the lenses encounter each various other directly and rest 4 to 6 inches off the flooring, after that examination by passing a box via the beam of light as the door closes.
- Clear and lube the course. Sweep particles from the tracks, then clean the rollers and joints with a rag. Apply a garage door rated lube, not oil, to rollers, hinges, and torsion springtime birthing plates. Do not lube the tracks themselves. If you have a chain drive opener, a dab of grease on revealed chain segments can decrease chatter.
- Test balance and guidebook release carefully. With the door closed, pull the red launch cable to separate the opener. Lift the door by hand to mid height. If it stays within a couple of inches of where you leave it, your springs are approximately stabilized. If it slams or shoots up, reconnect the opener and call a pro. Do not change springtimes yourself.

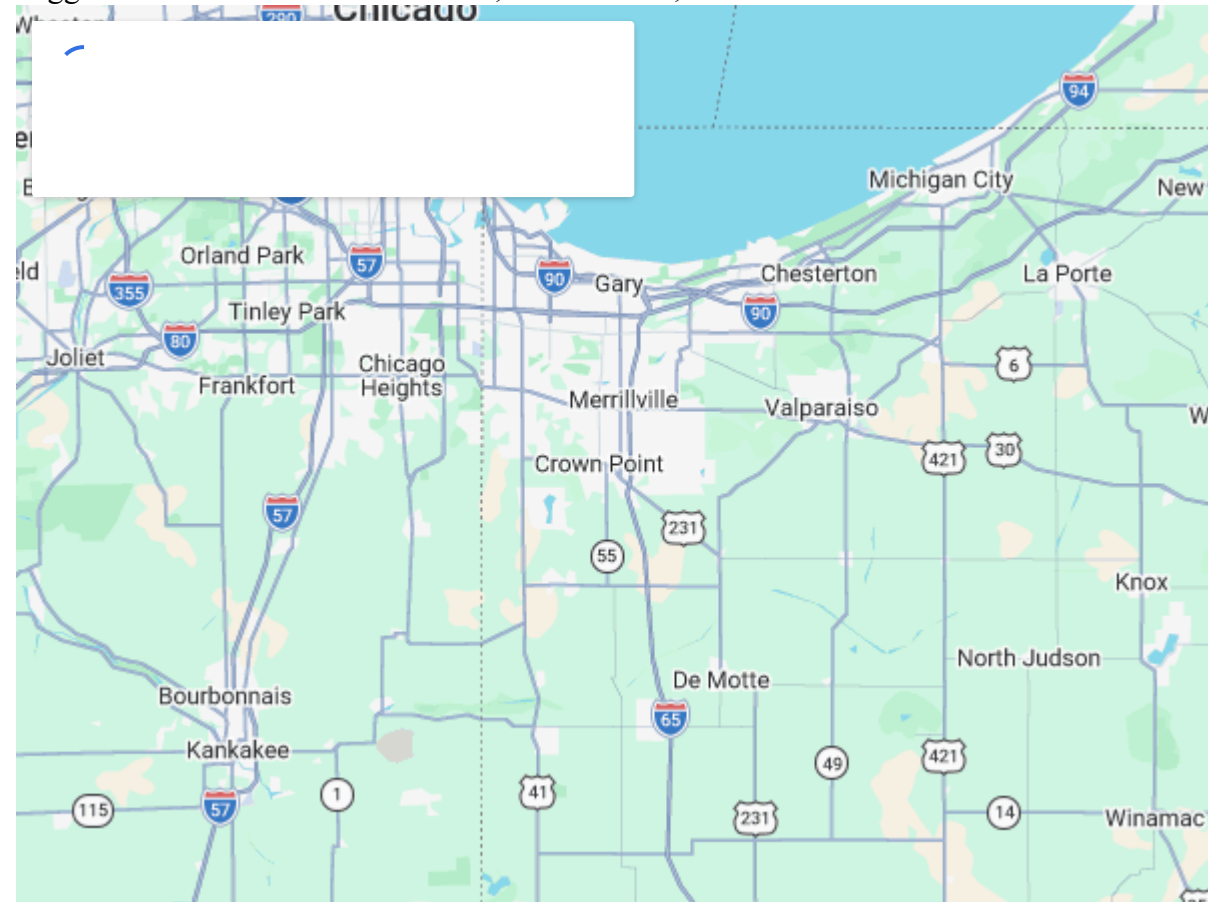
