It also establishes a gray patina that some folks adore and others buff away annually or two. If you care about crisp brightness around the diamond but yearn for a yellow gold shank, request for platinum eagle points on a gold scalp or even a two-tone container. They combined it with a simple platinum band so the metallics touching coincided, decreasing galvanic wear.
