These 5 points prevent the typical civilian casualties I see in Hobart and Merrillville: fell short openers from repeated slamming, distorted panels from prying with boards, and bruised shins from cord lash.

What most repairs expense and why

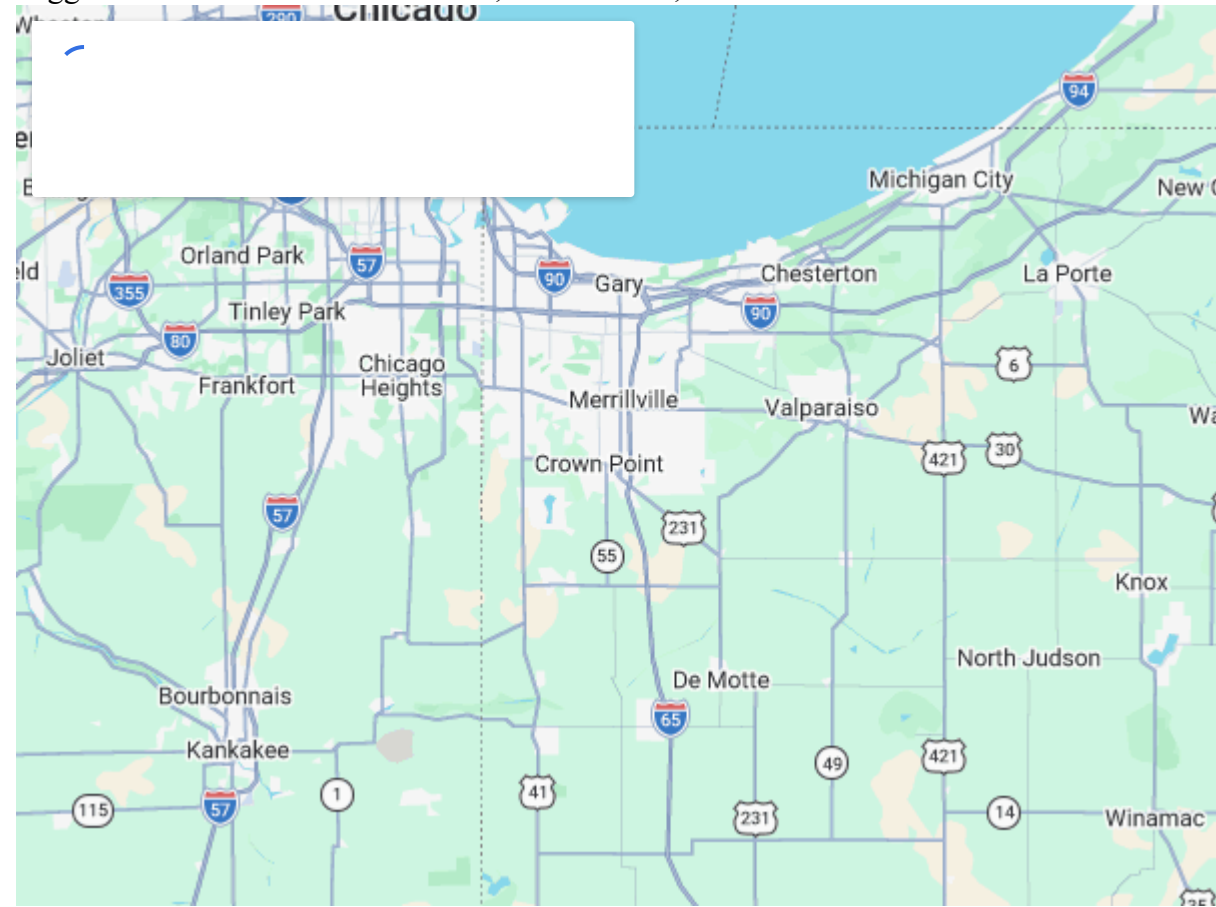
