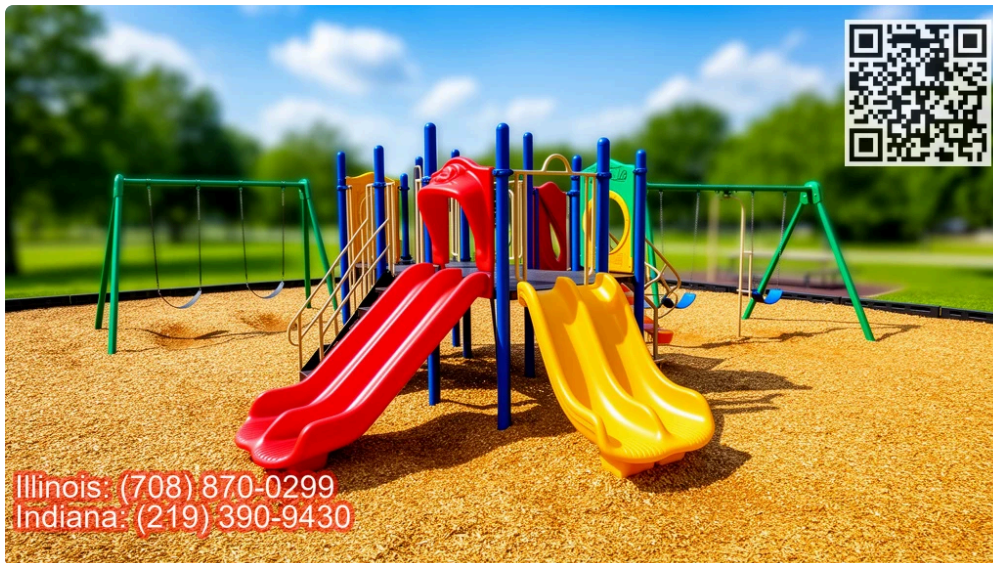

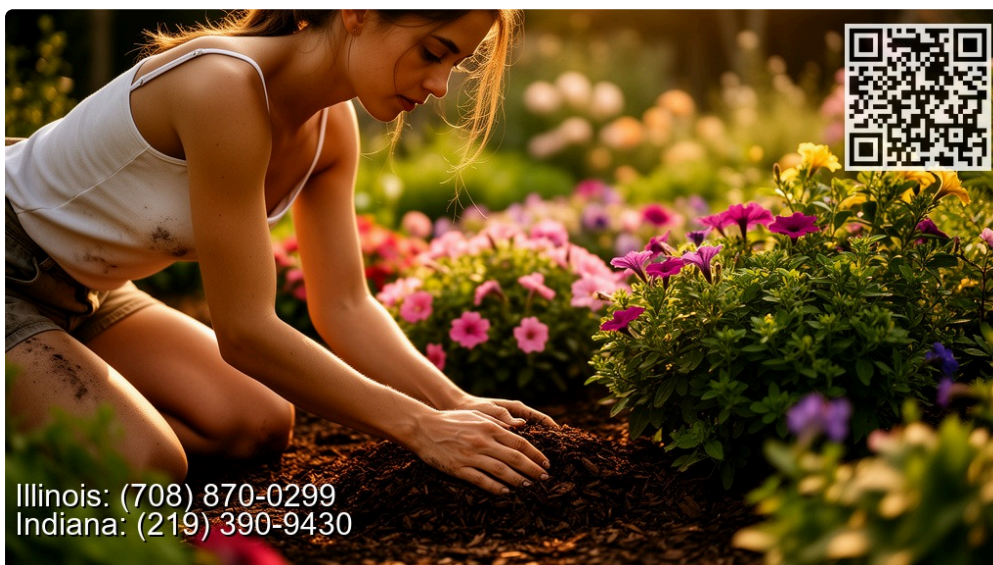

Weed pressure drops greatly, and what sneaks through is easier to tug from loose, shaded dirt. Handling edge cases: origins, slopes, and runoff

Exposed surface area origins on older maples or oaks lure people to hide them. Stand up to need.
