The parts triumphing wind all over the summer time months is the notorious Meltemi blowing from the N-NW. It is first felt in June and becomes stronger by using July, August and September while it could actually reach power 8. It dies down in October. In the spring and autumn gales are known from the N and the SE. The summer time months are warm, commonplace temperatures are 25 deg C and temperatures as a rule attain 35 deg C.

Milos is the southwesternmost of the Cyclades. A widespread bay, Ormos Milou, used to be scooped out while an ancient volcano erupted and hot sulphur springs nonetheless exist at the present time. There is water at the ferry pier and gasoline should be would be could very well be introduced. Most provisions is also got in the village and there are a few tavernas. Climb the hill to the Chora at Milos for breathtaking perspectives across the bay. There are a number of different anchorages in the bay which can be uncovered to the north. There are no services at any of them. Apollonia is inside the NE of Milos. Go bow or stern to the pier or anchor of the seaside. Holding is right on a sandy backside. There are tavernas and a mini industry ashore. Ormos Voudhia lies one mile to the south of Apollonia. There is ideal safeguard from the Meltemi but the environment are unattractive with open solid mines and a wharf and ore provider all in view.

Kimilos lies to the NE of Milos. There are two anchorages in Ormos Sikia inside the SW of the island. They are uncovered to the N – NW and flawed whilst the Meltemi is blowing. Pirgonisi is a long sandy seaside on the south coast and yachts can anchor virtually anyplace alongside it in desirable atmosphere. Good retaining on sand and weed. Psathi lies similarly alongside the coast to the east. Go bows to the marina or anchor off. There is little safe haven from the Meltemi and yachts are instructed to use this anchorage most effective in calm weather. There are several tavernas ashore and restrained provisions can be got inside the village. Just to the north is Semina Creek and yachts can anchor in the bay. Like Psathi, there's little look after from the Meltemi and Psathi will have to be used handiest in calm climate.

The inside the NW of island of Poliagos there may be a wonderful secluded anchorage [Cabo San Lucas all inclusive boat rentals](#) simply to the south of the tiny island of Moanolsi. There is shield from the Meltemi and fantastic holding on the sandy backside. On the south area of the island there are a couple of coves that yachts can anchor in whilst conditions are calm.

Folegandros is an alternative barren, rocky island with exception of the small Chora in the NE that lies amongst inexperienced bushes and shrubs. The islands ferry port is Karavostasi. Go bow or stern to the mole on the south area of the arm extending westward. There is bad retaining in places on sand and rock. There is affordable shield from the Meltemi. There are countless tavernas yet provisions is additionally elaborate to obtain and the island is thoroughly reliant on deliveries by way of ferry. On the W area of Folegandros is the large bay, Ormos Vathi. It can only be used in calm climate and there may be terrible holding in areas on sand and weed.

Sikinos lies to the E of Folegandros. Ormos Skala is the best harbour at the island. Yachts can go along the quay or anchor off. There are tavernas ashore and some provisions could be bought. The environment is horny and usual with Greek vacationers.

3.5 miles to the east of Sikinos lies Ios. It is alleged Homer is buried right here. He died aboard a ship on passage from Samos to Athens and his physique was thrown overboard and later washed up on Ios. Go bow or stern to in the harbour of Port Ios. There is suitable keeping in dust. A mini tanker can carry gas and water is achievable from a public fountain inside the rectangular. There are tavernas all around the harbour and most provisions shall be received. The motel is famous with the young and most of the bars play loud music inside the evenings/night time. Ormos Milopotamou lies to the S of Port Ios. In the north of the bay there are 4 coves where yachts can anchor, the easterly two present the most sensible shield. Holding is good on sand. There are tavernas and lodges on the seaside. Ormos Manganari is a immense bay on the south coast of Ios, that is plausible to anchor in the time of the bay with remarkable holding on sand. There are tavernas ashore.

Thira is such as Milos in as so much as it really is a volcano and while it erupted in 1440 1450 BC it created the bay as it's miles right this moment. The near mendacity islands of Thirasia, Nea Kammeni and Palaia Kammeni are also component of this good sized volcanic architecture. Around the basin, on cliffs 300m top one can see white Cycladic houses with blue painted home windows hanging from black volcanic rocks which rise sheer from the sea all team together to make Thira is one of the so much renowned destinations in Greece.

Finikia lies inside the N of Thira. Anchor to the W of the mole in 10 20m with a trip line in view that the ground is rocky. Limited shelter from the Meltemi and fully open to the S. Skala Thira is the harbour of the islands capital on the steep

slopes above. Go bow or stern to the marina with a line to the wide mooring buoy. Departing is hard with the confusion of the numerous lines hooked up to the buoy and that's commended that yachts should not left unattended. There is water on the quay and countless tavernas inside the harbour.

On the coast south of Ak Akrotiri there are a variety anchorages that offer true take care of from the Meltemi. The bottom is right retaining in sand yet there's mostly a few flooring swell that motives yachts to roll badly. Monolithos is a small harbour at the E coast. Go bows to the breakwater close to its extremity with a protracted line. There is a taverna and showers ashore.

Thirasia is the westernmost island and the merely anchorage is Ayios Nikolaos. Yachts can anchor off however the small pier is reserved for local boats. There are tavernas ashore and a few provisions are achieveable in the village atop the cliffs.

Nea Kammeni has quite a number small inlets where a yacht can anchor. A experience line need to be used as the ground is strewn with rocks which might be in all likelihood to snag an anchor. Nea Kammeni is understood for its concern with tremendous rats and there are lots of stories of the getting aboard yachts.

Anafi is the southernmost of the Cyclades. It has one anchorage on the S coast that may be exposed. The island is barren and parched and you will not leave out lots should you decide on not to seek advice from.
