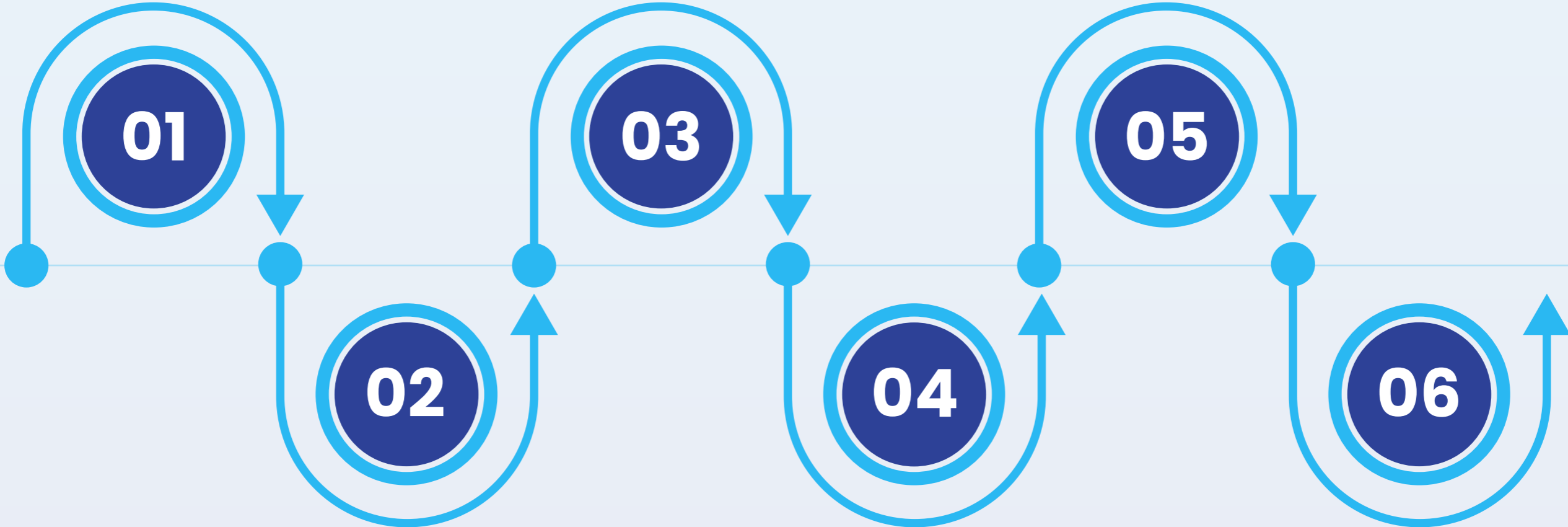

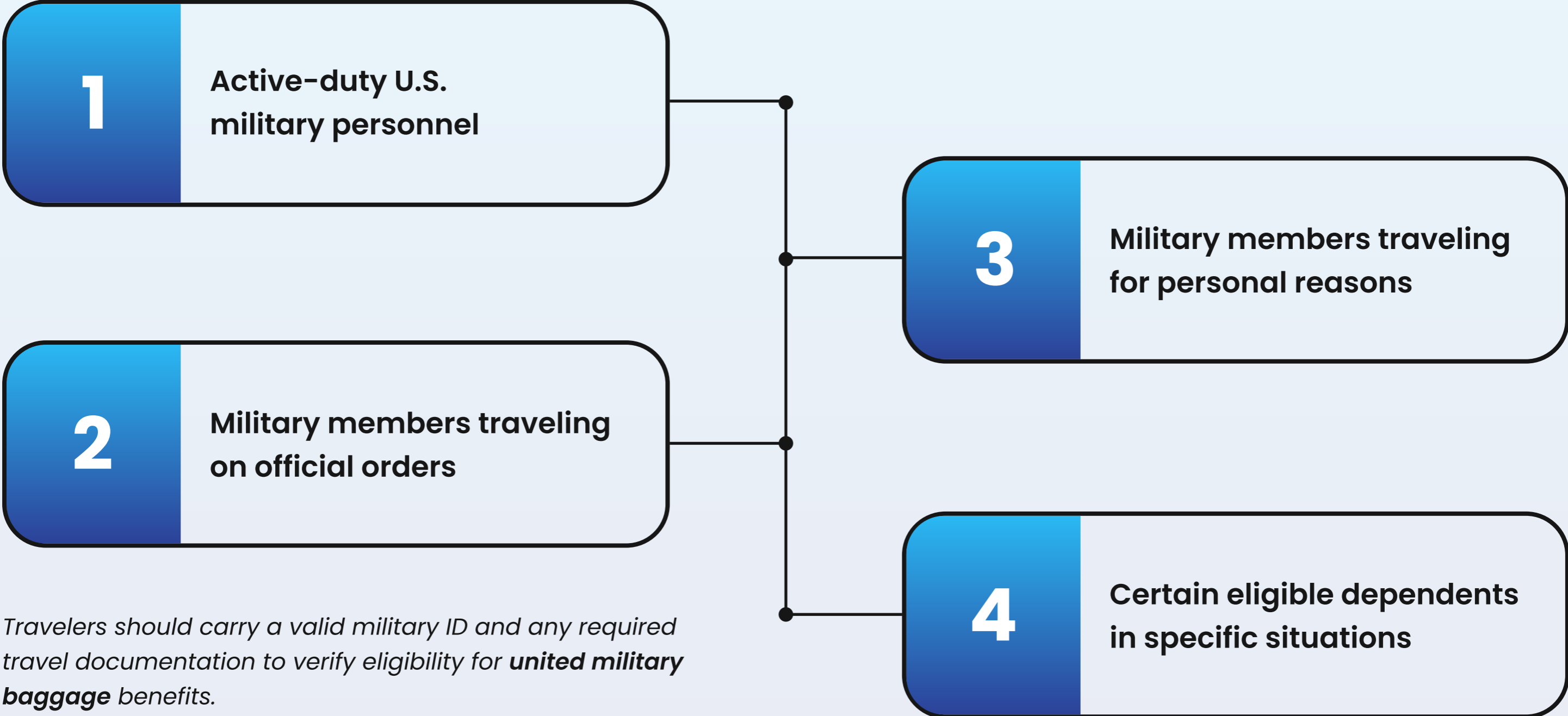

Who Qualifies for Military Baggage Benefits?

- 3 Flexible baggage allowances

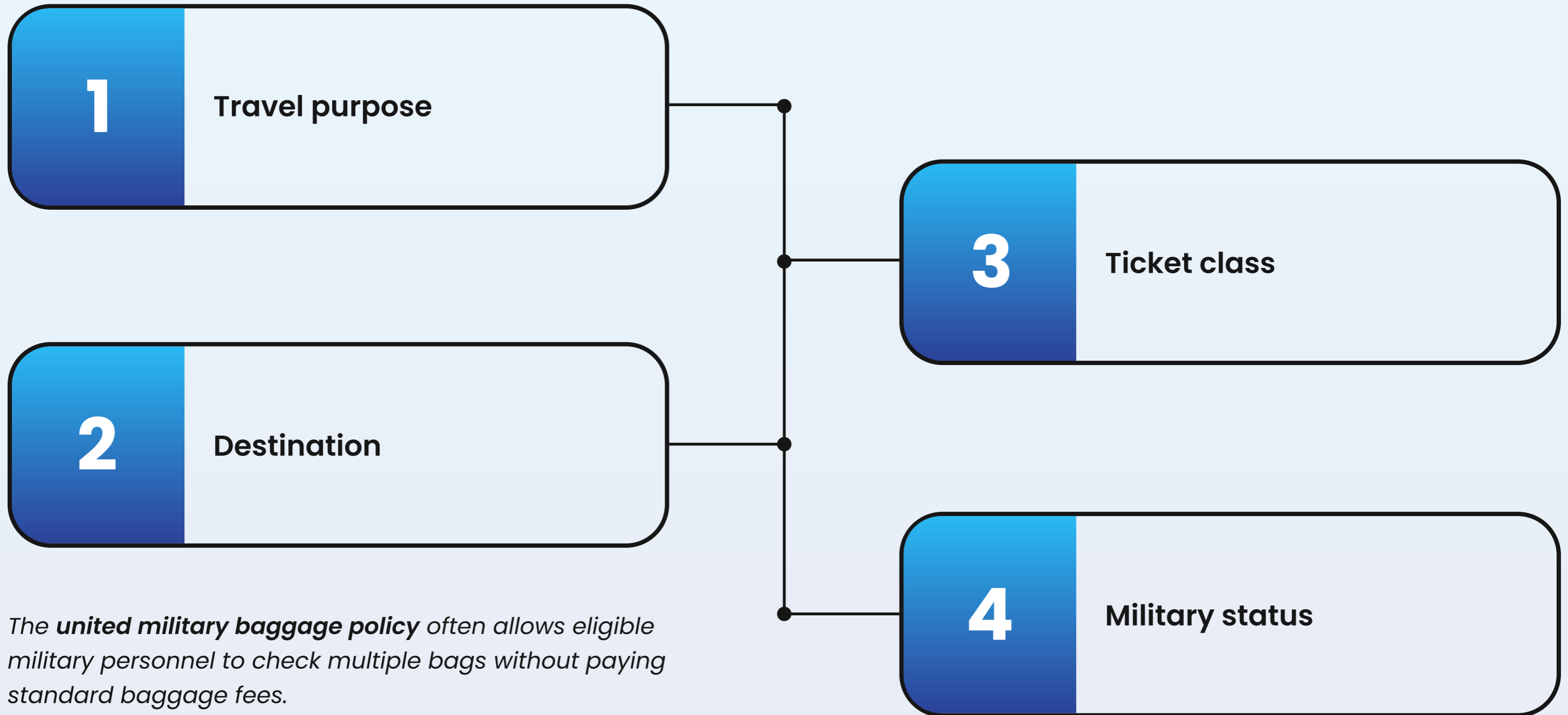
These benefits help service members save money during vacations, family visits, and personal trips.

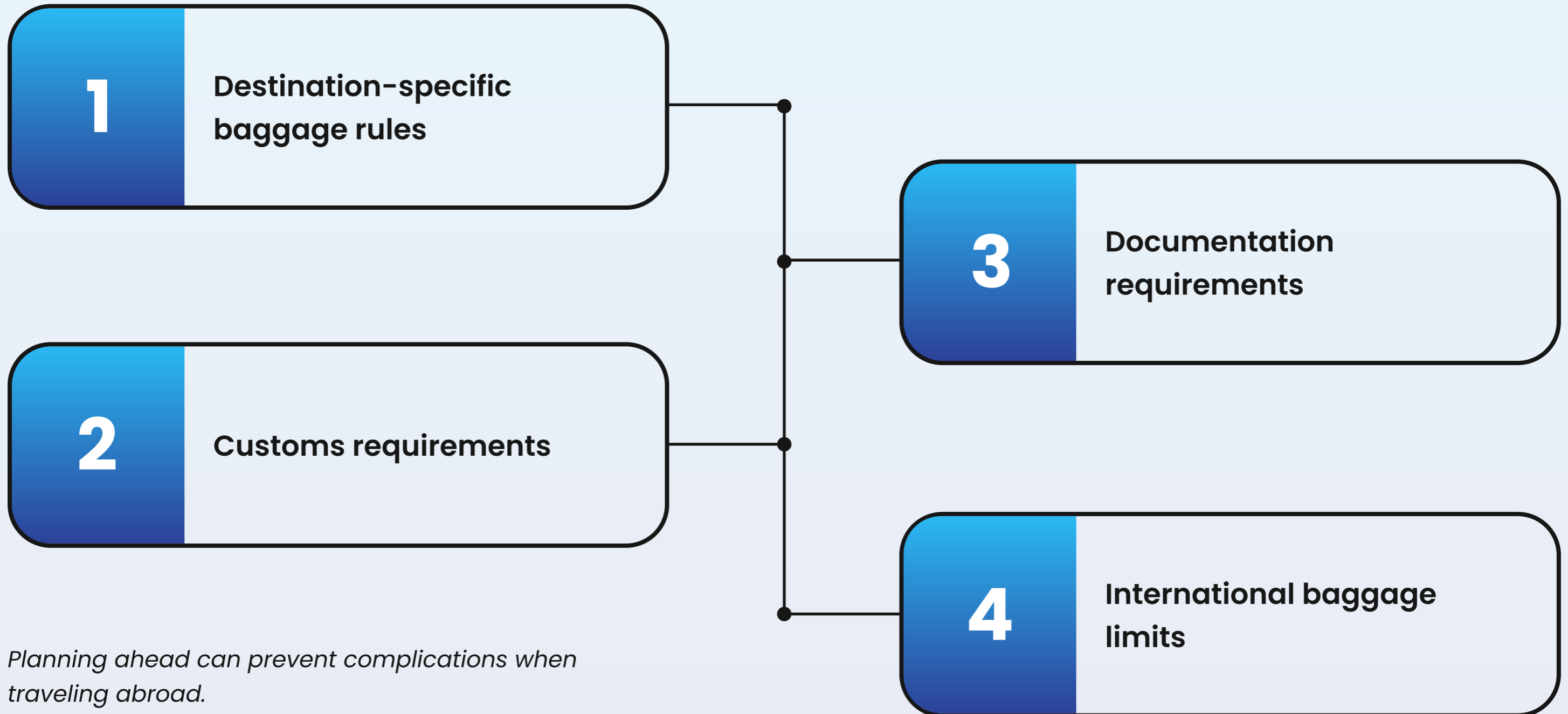
The **united military baggage policy** may provide accommodations for certain authorized equipment when traveling on official orders.
