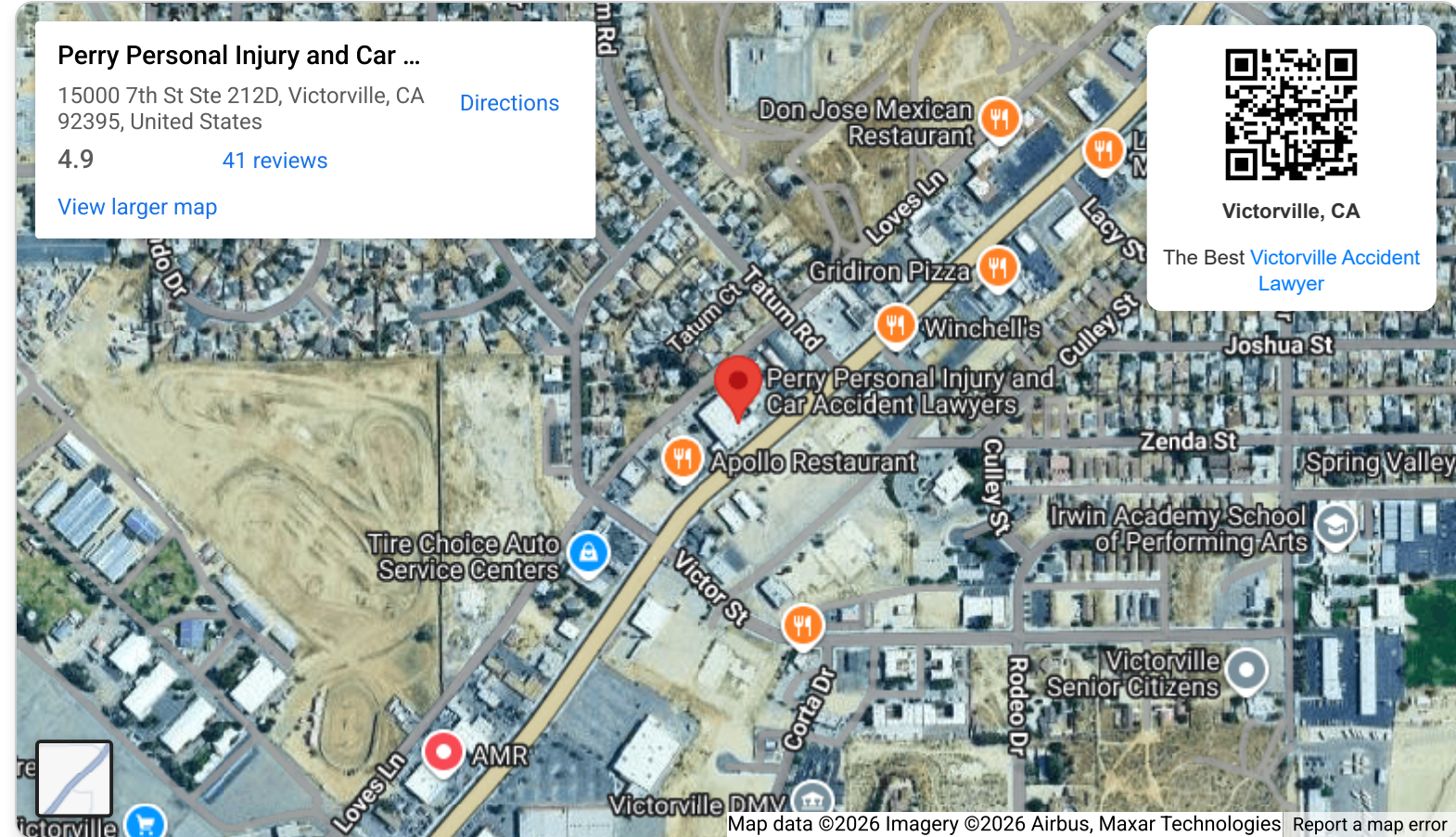

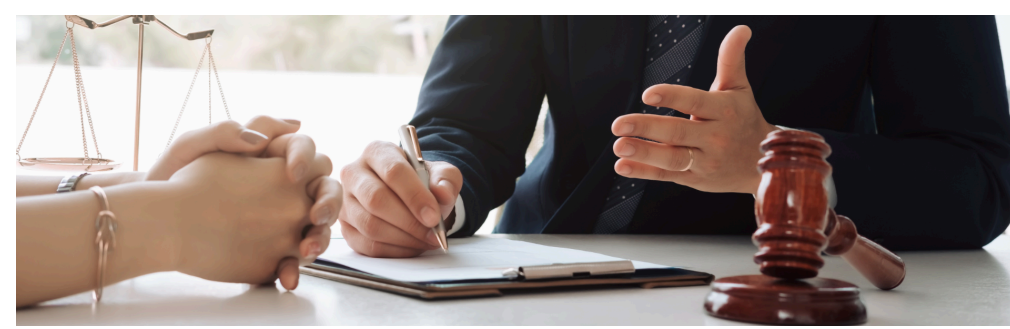

If an auto accident occurred on March 2, 2021, the victim would have until March 2, 2023, to legally sue. However, if you are calling a governmental entity as an accused, your target date for filing notification is six months from the car mishap date.
