Some situations justify monthly visits, such as heavy pressure, recurring activity, or specific pest issues. Termite risk is often managed with periodic inspections and ongoing monitoring systems rather than only “spray” visits. The right frequency depends on pest history, construction type, and surrounding environment.
