When you come back , you'll be actually refreshed again. The fire will have had time to recharge .

Celebrate the Milestones

Distinguish between date nights and wedding work . Date nights are for you . No vendor decisions . Just fun .

Planning nights are intentional and focused . Two hours on Tuesday . Then close the laptop .

This boundary maintains your sanity and keeps the preparation from dominating your everything.

New Environments

Researching in the same environment month after month is draining . Your mind links that room with work .

Switch locations . Different coffee shop . Small change can bring new ideas.

Pinterest are filled with perfect photos . Gorgeous. And at the same time unrealistic . Consuming only professional editorials will make you feel like you're not doing enough.

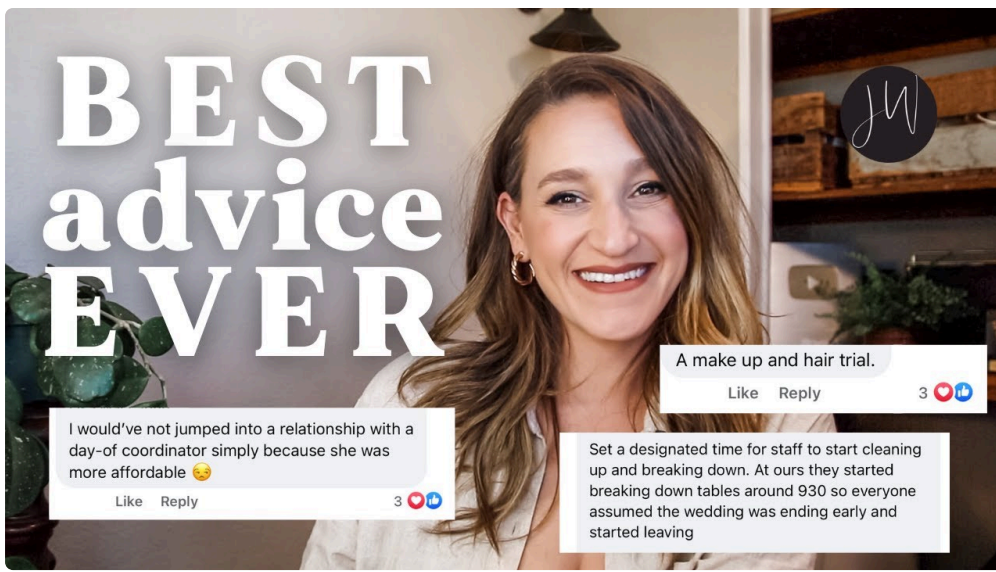
Add some reality . Seek out real wedding galleries . Images from non-influencers. Events that feel like something you could genuinely afford.
