What we install in PSL, and what it costs

We install keypad and app-based smart deadbolts from Schlage, Kwikset, Yale, Level, and Ulltion for exterior doors in Port St. Lucie. Expect \$189 to \$329 for hardware on entry-level Wi-Fi models, and \$349 to \$599 for premium, high-security, or Apple Home Key options. Installation and setup runs \$125 to \$175 per door, including removing the old lock, squaring the strike, and pairing your app. Service call in St. Lucie County is usually \$39 to \$59, waived on multi-door jobs. Bottom line: a complete, clean smart lock setup in PSL lands between \$289 and \$489 for most homes.

We also rekey your existing keyed cylinders to match, usually \$19 to \$25 per keyhole. If you’re in Tradition or St. Lucie West, we can be there in about 25 to 35 minutes from Crosstown Parkway traffic. Need door prep fixes because the deadbolt binds after 3 pm heat? We shim, chisel, and adjust until it throws smooth.

PSL smart lock options we recommend, and why

We install what we trust. After 3,500+ smart lock jobs, a few models stand out. Schlage Encode and Encode Plus hold up in coastal air better than most. Yale Assure works great on rental turnovers because the keypad is bright and the app is simple. Level Bolt is our pick when you want to keep your original handleset. And yes, we’ve seen Kwikset SmartKey get iffy if the door’s out of plumb. Honest take.

If you’re all-in on Apple, Schlage Encode Plus supports Apple Home Key, so your Apple Watch can open the door. For Airbnbs near Jensen Beach or by the PSL Botanical Gardens, we lean Yale + August modules because guest code management is fast. We program auto-lock to 30 or 60 seconds for doors that don’t close tight in summer humidity. Saves headaches.

According to manufacturer guidance from Schlage and Yale, keypad gaskets must compress evenly to keep rain out. We always check that with a torque screwdriver. Small detail. Big difference in August storms.

Will smart locks handle Florida weather and PSL door shifts?

Short answer, yes, if the door and strike are aligned and the latch isn’t fighting the frame. PSL heat swells wood. Afternoon sea breeze cools it down. That movement binds bolts. We see it daily in homes off Becker Road and around Torino Parkway. Our fix is simple: set the door on the hinge side, shim the top hinge if needed, and file the strike just a hair. Then we set the auto-lock delay longer, so the bolt isn’t trying to throw mid-slam.

We add dielectric grease on outdoor battery contacts. We also recommend lithium AA batteries, not alkaline, because they handle heat better. Expect battery changes every 6 to 9 months. We write the install date on the inside plate. Old-school trick that saves guesswork.

Safety, codes, and what Florida requires on exits

You can’t put anything on a residential egress door that needs a special tool or knowledge to exit. That’s straight from the Florida Building Code 7th Edition and echoed by NFPA 101 Life Safety Code. In plain English, your front door must

open with one motion. No weird double actions. We set smart locks so the inside thumb turn works like a normal deadbolt, even if Wi-Fi is down.

For commercial doors in St. Lucie County, electronic locks must release on fire alarm and power loss. We wire or verify that release under the applicable sections of the Florida Building Code and NFPA 101. If you’re unsure about your door on a retail space near the Civic Center, we’ll check it and show you the exact clause before we install. No guessing.

Source names you can cite: Florida Building Code 7th Edition, Chapter 10 Means of Egress; NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, Chapter 7. Manufacturer install specs from Schlage and Yale call this out as well.

Smart lock brands we trust in PSL

We’ve installed almost every brand available at Home Depot on Gatlin and Lowe’s off US-1. Here’s the real talk.

- Schlage Encode and Encode Plus. Solid build, better plating against salt air, strong motors. App is reliable. Worth the extra \$50 to \$80.
- Yale Assure with Wi-Fi or Z-Wave module. Great key-free option. Very good in short-term rentals.
- Level Bolt. Invisible. Keeps your existing hardware. Needs a clean bore and good strike.
- Ultion Nuki for higher-security cylinders. Less common here, but we stock a few.

We’re not big fans of the cheapest Wi-Fi locks with mystery brands. Batteries die fast, apps glitch, and the plating pits by year two near the Fort Pierce Inlet breeze. If a client insists, we’ll install, but we warn up front. Your call.

According to Schlage’s published specs, Encode Plus supports Apple Home Key with iOS 15 or later. You can verify that on the Schlage site. Always good to match your ecosystem before you buy.

A quick checklist to pick the right lock in Port St. Lucie

- 1) Measure your door prep. Confirm 2 3/8 or 2 3/4 backset and 1 inch bolt throw.
- 2) Choose your ecosystem. Apple Home, Google Home, or just keypad.
- 3) Decide on keyway. Keep your house keyed alike or go key-free.
- 4) Check the finish. PSL sun fades cheap finishes fast.
- 5) Set guest code needs. Rentals near Jensen Beach need quick code changes.

That’s it. Five decisions. We walk you through them in 10 minutes on site.

Real jobs we finished last week in PSL and nearby

Tuesday, Tradition: client’s Yale lock kept jamming at 4 pm. Door was proud at the top. We pulled the top hinge pin, tweaked with a shim, filed the strike 1 mm, set a 60 second auto-lock. Total time 55 minutes. No more jams.

Thursday, St. Lucie West: Schlage Encode Plus install with Apple Home Key. Two doors, matching finish. We rekeyed the garage door to their existing SC1 keys. Hardware \$398 x2, labor \$150 per door, service call waived. Programmed 4 family codes and a dog walker code. Happy client.

Saturday, Palm City: vacation rental off Martin Downs. Yale keypad with Wi-Fi bridge so they can send codes remotely. We set a 4-hour temporary code for cleaners between guest stays. Took 70 minutes.

We keep photos of before and after on file. If you want to see finish options against your door color, we’ll show real jobs on similar homes.

Will this work with your current door and frame?

Most PSL exterior doors are standard 2 1/8 inch bore with a separate deadbolt, so yes. If you’ve got a multipoint door from a custom builder in Verano or PGA Village, we’ll need a compatible smart cylinder or a specialty retrofit. Expect parts in 2 to 5 days for multipoint. We’ve done them, and they come out clean, just slightly pricier.

If your storm door hits a keypad, we have low-profile options. Level, or a slim Yale. And if your Wi-Fi drops near the garage, we set it up on Bluetooth first, then add a Wi-Fi bridge closer to your router. Simple fix.

Security tips we give every PSL homeowner with a new smart lock

Two things matter more than the app. Door alignment and code discipline. If the bolt drags, the motor strains and batteries die early. We set the strike so the bolt throws without touching the sides. Then we ask you to set a 6-digit primary code and a 1-time code for vendors. Don't reuse birthdays. Obvious, but people do it. We also enable lockout after 5 bad tries where supported.

If you keep a traditional key override, we rekey that to match the rest of the house. No loose keys under a mat. Please. We see that every week, near Sandhill Crane Park and around Savannas Preserve. Bad habit.

Warranty, licensing, and how we stand behind it

All smart lock installs from include a 1-year labor warranty. Hardware warranty depends on brand, commonly 1 to limited lifetime on finish and 1 to 3 years on electronics. We're insured, background checked, and operate with the required St. Lucie County business tax receipt. You get an itemized invoice with model numbers for your records. If a keypad fails under warranty, we handle the swap. No runaround.

DIY vs pro install in PSL: what we've learned

Could you install it yourself? Sure. But here's what happens. People chase Wi-Fi setup for an hour because the 2.4 GHz band is turned off on the router. Or the deadbolt binds by 1 mm and eats batteries in three weeks. Or the latch is upside down. We fix those three issues constantly. Usually in 35 to 50 minutes.

If you want to try it, start with Schlage Encode. The app's simple. If you want a flush, perfect plate, square screws, and a bolt that glides, we're happy to do it. Worth it if your time is tight.

Q: How much does smart lock installation cost in PSL?

A: Most PSL installs land between \$289 and \$489 per door including hardware and labor. Premium or multipoint setups run \$550 to \$950. Labor is \$125 to \$175 per door, and the St. Lucie County service call is \$39 to \$59, often waived on multi-door jobs. Exact quote by text in minutes.

Q: Do smart locks hold up in Florida humidity and salt air?

A: Yes, if you choose quality finishes and the door is aligned. We see Schlage Encode and Yale Assure do well near coastal air. We add gaskets correctly and use lithium batteries. Expect 6 to 9 months on a battery set, sometimes a year in shaded entries.

Q: Can you rekey my other doors to match the new smart lock?

A: Absolutely. We rekey existing cylinders to your preferred keyway [Click for more info](#) so one key works everywhere. Rekeying usually runs \$19 to \$25 per keyhole. We do it during the same visit so you're set when we leave.

Q: Will a smart lock work with my HOA rules in PSL?

A: Most HOAs allow keypad deadbolts as long as the exterior finish matches community standards. We've installed in Tradition, Verano, and St. Lucie West with no issues. We can provide model photos and spec sheets for HOA approval before install.

Q: What happens if the power or internet goes out?

A: Your door still locks and unlocks. Smart locks run on batteries and the inside thumb turn always works. Apps won't sync without Wi-Fi, but keypad codes still function. That aligns with Florida Building Code egress requirements and manufacturer design.

Q: Which smart lock is best for Airbnbs and short-term rentals?

A: We like Yale with Wi-Fi or August modules for quick guest code changes and clear logs. Schlage Encode works well too. Installed, you're usually \$329 to \$489 per door in PSL. We'll set temporary codes and show you how to expire them between stays.

Q: How long does installation take?

A: Standard swap takes 45 to 90 minutes per door. Add 15 to 25 minutes if we need to adjust hinges or the strike. Multipoint doors take longer, often 90 to 120 minutes, sometimes with a special cylinder order.

Sources and standards we follow

According to the Florida Building Code 7th Edition, Chapter 10 Means of Egress, residential egress doors must allow single-motion exit without special knowledge. NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, Chapter 7, reinforces free egress on power loss for electronic locks in commercial settings. Manufacturer specs from Schlage and Yale outline required door prep, gasket compression, and battery types. You can review Schlage Encode Plus specs on Schlage’s official site, and Florida Building Code references at the Florida Building Commission.

Frequently Asked Q&A's

How much money does a locksmith charge?

Locksmith services typically cost between \$150 and \$250 for common tasks like home lockouts, with a national average of roughly \$187–\$226. Basic car lockouts usually cost \$89–\$150, while replacing standard locks or rekeying ranges from \$50 to \$200+. Costs are higher for emergency, after-hours, or weekend services.

Is it cheaper to call a locksmith or replace a lock?

You can change the locks yourself or hire a pro to replace or rekey the lock, which costs \$50 to \$100. Replacing a lock costs an average of \$315, as it requires a fair amount of both materials and labor. Professional locksmiths charge an average of \$75 per hour, and you won't need to replace the hardware.

How much does a locksmith charge for a replacement car key?

Locksmith car key replacement typically costs between \$150 and \$250+, heavily dependent on key complexity and vehicle model. Simple metal keys cost \$95–\$100, while transponder keys are \$100–\$250, and modern smart key fobs range from \$200–\$600+. Locksmiths are generally cheaper than dealerships, which may also charge for towing.

Can I get a replacement key for my car without the original?

You don't need the original key to replace your car key, but you may be asked to demonstrate ownership of your vehicle before an automotive locksmith or dealership will rekey the car.



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
